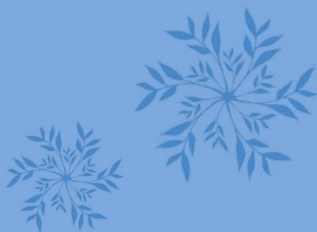
Pajamas (M, L, XL)
